

Until Our Last Breath: A Holocaust Story of Love and Partisan Resistance

Michael Bart will speak on his new book. The title comes from a speech given in the Vilna ghetto by resistance leader Abba Kovner where he said, "We shall not go like sheep to slaughter, we shall fight until our last breath." Bart took personal information and documentation shared by his parents, spent over 10 years researching their experiences in the Vilna ghetto, and as members of the Partisans of Vilna with Abba Kovner's Avengers group.

The book has been nominated for a Sophie Brody Award, an award from the American Library Association for the most distinguished contribution to Jewish literature published in the United States. This national award is named in memory for CBI member Sophie Brody.
